



## Dacono Critical Repair Information

**Thank you for your interest in volunteering with Habitat for Humanity of the St. Vrain Valley!** The following is general information regarding volunteering on a Habitat Critical Repair Project.

**WHEN:** We build from **9 AM until 4:00 PM**. We ask that our volunteers commit to a full day. Volunteer Safety Orientation begins promptly at 9 AM the morning you volunteer. Please plan to arrive about 15 minutes early to sign-in and take care of paperwork. Volunteers who arrive after the safety orientation may not be able to participate.

**FORMS:** Please read our **Work Crew Safety Manual** and complete the **Release and Waiver** before arriving at the site. The **Release and Waiver** must be witnessed by a Habitat employee at the site when you arrive to volunteer. Minors (ages 16 and over) must have their **Release and Waiver for Minors** signed by a Parent/Guardian and their Parent/Guardian's signature must be witnessed before they are permitted on the worksite. *Note: Waivers only need to be filled out once per year for each site.*



**WHERE:** We have multiple construction sites in *The Glens* subdivision, off Hwy. 52 and Glen Creighton Drive in Dacono. **The specific address for your build day is in the confirmation email you received. If you have questions about where to meet on the day of, feel free to contact the construction supervisor, Brother Grimes, at 337-322-3277.**

**WHAT:** Critical repair projects consist of exterior work such as roofing repair, replacing siding, exterior paint and landscaping. Volunteers will also do interior work including replacing windows and doors, installing bathroom and kitchen fixtures, flooring, and painting.

**SUPPLIES:** Volunteering requires neither experience nor supplies. We provide enough equipment for everyone and instruction is provided. Please bring work gloves and safety glasses, if you have them. We have water jugs on site and ask **volunteers to bring a water bottle** to fill up and carry with them.

**ATTIRE:** It is always a good idea to wear sunscreen and to dress in layers for the unpredictable Colorado weather. **Close-toed shoes are required on the worksite at all times.** Volunteers should wear appropriate

clothing (items that can get dirty and for painting). Clothing should not be too loose-fitting, as baggy clothing can cause a safety hazard.

**LUNCH:** There will be a 45-minute break for lunch. **Lunch is NOT provided.** Please plan to bring a lunch or find something in the area.

**WEATHER:** It is not often that we are forced to cancel due to adverse weather conditions. However, it is a possibility if the safety of the volunteers a concern to the Construction Site Supervisor. Therefore, **if you are scheduled to volunteer on a day on which weather conditions are questionable, the office phone voice mail will be updated by 7:15 AM** to indicate whether or not construction will take place as scheduled. Please call the office at **303-682-2485 (Ext. 6)** should this become the case on your scheduled volunteered day.

**SCHEDULING:** We ask that volunteers **please register in advance** so that we may ensure that there are enough work and supplies for everyone. Individuals who have not scheduled in advance will not be accommodated on the worksite.

**PRAYER:** Habitat was founded in 1976 as an ecumenical Christian organization to assist low income individuals in purchasing simple, decent, affordable homes that they would otherwise not have the opportunity to own. **In keeping with this non-denominational Christian history, a prayer is typically said at the beginning of the workday.** Of course, participation is always optional.
